Getting books to your **Computer**:

Adobe Digital Editions (FREE)

Flash Player 9.0+

get.adobe.com/flashplayer/

And Javascript!

For Audiobooks you'll need the **Overdrive Media Console**:

overdrive.com/software/omc

This Console is also available as an application for several devices capable of playing audio files. These include: *Android, Blackberry, iPhone, iPad, Windows Phone 7*, etc...

Kobo uses *Adobe Digital Editions* AND the *Kobo Application* to sort/organize and copy content. Ebooks can be returned early with the Kobo. The Kobo App can be downloaded from:

Sony Devices use the *Sony Reader Application* and can also be returned early; the application can be downloaded from:

ebookstore.sony.com/reader/

Blackberry Devices use the *Blackberry Desktop application*. This Desktop App can be downloaded from:

ca.blackberry.com/apps-software/desktop/

***Each Device** will use their own software and procedure from their manufacturer.*

The Infamous Adobe ID:

With this you can **Authorize** your ADE and get books anywhere in the world! By plugging a device into your computer with an authorized ADE open you are prompted to authorize the device!

To **De-Authorize** the DEVICE from a public computer press:

Control+Shift+E

To **De-Authorize** the USER from a public computer press:

Control+Shift+D

Once this is setup once on your Computer head back to our website and click the **Overdrive link**. Then search for *eBooks* or *Audiobooks* and use your Library card to access your eAccount!

Search for books and follow the steps for your device to copy the books over!

You'll Need:

- A Valid *Alberta Library Card* (with no Late Fees!)
- *Internet Access*
- A *Computer* and/or *Mobile Device* with appropriate software downloaded

You can check online to see if your device is supported or check to see which ones are before you buy!
